MEAL CHARGING GUIDELINES

Check "Lunch Money Now" for student balances and daily meal activity!



\$20 limit for meal charges in the MAIN LINE

•••

NO SNACK BAR items may be charged

BEGINNING JANUARY 2014:

Students who have cafeteria charges, will not be allowed to eat in the snack bar until the charges are paid in full.

Additional Information:

- Items such as cookies, ice cream, Gatorade, Splash, bottled water, bottled juices, fruit, or "Seconds" **cannot** be charged.
- Students are notified verbally on a daily basis when they pass through the cafeteria line if they are close to or have a negative balance.
- Cafeteria charge balances are sent to each campus weekly for distribution to students to be taken home to parents or guardians.
- When students reach charges totaling \$10 or more, a letter will be mailed home to the student's parent or guardian. An alternative meal will be served to the student if the charges are not paid.
- Charges will not be allowed two months prior to the end of school. Students will be given the alternative meal as soon as they reach a zero balance.

Alternative meal consist of:

- Cheese Sandwich
- Fruit
- Milk

Ways to pay for your child's meal:

- Send money daily with the student to cover that day's meal.
- Send money to be added to their account balance on a regular basis.
- Add money on-line through "Lunch Money Now".
 You will need their Student ID, Last four digits of their Social Security Number, and their date-of-birth.
